



Summer Registration Information & Policies

Required Deposits (Non-Refundable)

- Pioneer Camp - \$50
- Mountain Village, Wilderness Ridge, Aspen View, Lodge Camp - \$100
- Narrow Way Expedition Trips-\$150

Required Paperwork:

After completing your online registration, you will be required to submit a set of paperwork for each camper. A list of this paperwork is described below. This list can also be viewed on our website by clicking [HERE](#). We highly recommend that you upload all additional paperwork using the "Camper Paperwork Uploader" which you will find after you submit your registration application.

- **CURRENT PHYSICAL**

Parents are required to provide a copy of a current Physical (eg. sports physical, well check, etc.) for each of their registered children which is current within the previous 24 months. We have a simple [Physical Form](#) that you can give to your physician, or we can accept their form as long as the date and physician's signature is on it.

- **CURRENT IMMUNIZATION RECORD OR SIGNED IMMUNIZATION EXEMPTION**

An up-to-date immunization record is also required for camp attendance. If you live in the State of Colorado, this can be obtained from the [CDPHE website](#) or you can send a copy from your doctor's office. If you do not immunize, you may fill out and sign the [Immunization Exemption Form](#). If you are not a resident of Colorado, we will still need a current immunization record from your state or a signed Immunization Exemption Form.

- **MEDICATION FORM**

If your child is going to be bringing medications (including OTC medications, vitamins, homeopathic remedies, essential oils, medical ointments, etc.) with them into camp, you will need to print out the [Medication Form](#). This will need to be filled out and signed by a medical care professional.

- **RAFTING & OFF-SITE WAIVERS**

High School Camps and many Narrow Way Expedition Trips contract with outside companies which require their own waivers. If your child is registering for High School Camp, you will be required to complete [Noah's Ark On-line Waiver](#). For Narrow Way Expedition Trips, click [HERE](#) and navigate to your specific trip to view any additional required paperwork.

IdRaHaJe Cancellation Policy:

You may cancel your registration anytime, however, in most cases, your deposit will not be refunded. An additional 25% charge will be assessed if cancellations are not made at least **1 week prior to camp attendance**. If you fail to call in to cancel your registration prior to your Sunday check-in day, you will forfeit 50% of funds paid more than the deposit amount.

Transferring Camper Registration Weeks:

If you have registered your child and find that you need to move them to a different week, you may do so by calling the registration office at 303-838-0685. **PLEASE NOTE: YOUR FIRST TRANSFER IS FREE, BUT ANY SUBSEQUENT TRANSFERS WILL GENERATE A CHARGE OF \$30 PER REGISTRATION.**

Camper Spending Account:

You may add funds to a spending account for your child/children during the online registration process. Each child will receive a wristband at check-in with their account number on it and will be able to make purchases during their "free time" from the any of IdRaHaJe's stores, concession stands or Arts & Crafts, and Pottery. You can choose an amount from several options on the camp selection page. Any remaining balance from accounts created during the online registration process will be electronically refunded if the amount is \$2.00 or more. ****Please note that Lodge Camp campers are not able to use their spending account for expenses during their off-site rafting trip.**

****Narrow Way Expedition campers – Spending accounts are now available to all campers, however, some of the Narrow Way Expedition Trips do not allow for as much "free time" as Resident Camps because many of their activities are off-site. This year, you have the option of giving your child cash or adding money to a spending account if they are attending a Narrow Way Expedition Trip.**

Cabinmate Requests:

As a part of the registration process, each camper is allowed to request one cabinmate. Cabinmates must be of the same gender as the camper and attending the same resident camp. **We do our best to honor one request for each camper. To guarantee a request be fulfilled, the request must be mutual and only involve a pair of campers.** If more than one name is listed under the cabinmate requests, we will choose the first request. If your camper is not placed with their requested friend, this does not mean they will not be together during the week. There are plenty of opportunities to spend time during non-cabin activities. Also, we highly encourage campers to develop new friendships at camp.

PLEASE NOTE: In Wilderness Ridge, no more than 5 campers from one group will be assigned to the same tepee.

Campers with Special Needs:

If your child has significant educational, medical or behavioral needs, we require you to contact us at info@idrahaje.org prior to starting your registration. We will assess our ability to meet each child's needs on a case by case basis.

Additional Camper Options:

Other options such as horse rides (available for all residential camps for \$20/ride), bike rides (available for Aspen View & High School campers only for \$10/ride), etc. can be chosen on the Camp Selection Page during the online registration process. These are fee based activities and do create additional charges. If your child's horse ride or bike ride is cancelled due to weather, refunds will be made. However, if your child chooses not to attend a scheduled activity, no refund will be made.

On-site Medical Checks:

Trained IdRaHaJe Staff will perform a brief wellness check on each camper before their first night's stay in which the child's eyes, ears, throat, scalp and current injuries or signs of illnesses will be assessed. IdRaHaJe will notify the parent/guardian or an emergency contact if the child has any signs of illness, head lice or if the child becomes ill during their stay at Camp. **It is the parent's responsibility to arrange immediate pick-up from Camp if requested by a staff member.**
