



JOB DESCRIPTION – CAMP NURSE

Do you love summer camp? Do you have a heart for ministry? Do you enjoy a good adventure and want to make life-long friends? Do you want to see God move in incredible ways and change your life?

Then camp ministry might be the place for you.

IdRaHaJe, a Christian camp located in the Rocky Mountains of Colorado, is looking for nurses for the summer of 2019.

Eligible candidates include nursing graduates who are board ready, or nursing students with at least one year of clinical experience. Preference will be given to those who have already completed nursing school and are ready to sit for their exams.

Graduates are given time to study and are encouraged to take their NCLEX while here at camp. Time off will be given to drive to Denver to take the exam.

Camp IdRaHaJe nurses are split up among our 4 residential camps. Mountain Village serves campers ages 6-9 years old. Wilderness Ridge serves campers 9-12. Aspen View serves campers 11-13 and Lodge 14-18 years old. The nursing team is divided so that one nurse serves at each camp; however, the team works together closely to provide support and backup as necessary.

Camp nurse responsibilities include medication organization and administration, assessments, and basic first aid. Room and board as well as a small stipend is provided.
